



12 questions worth asking any ABA provider

Bring this to every interview — including ours. Good providers welcome these; evasive answers are an answer too.

☐ How are treatment goals chosen, and can you explain why each one matters?

☐ How will my child's preferences be built into sessions?

☐ What happens when my child communicates they need a break?

☐ How do you approach assent — and its withdrawal?

☐ Who designs the plan, and how often does the BCBA supervise?

☐ How are parents involved, and what will I learn?

☐ How do you decide how many weekly hours to recommend?

☐ How is progress measured, and what happens when it stalls?

☐ How do you support AAC and other communication systems?

☐ Do you target stimming — and if so, on what functional grounds?

☐ How do you coordinate with speech, OT, school, or physicians?

☐ What does reducing or ending therapy look like over time?
